

A Lifetime of Service

"Del, I have a burden on my heart that I want to share with you." My roommate, Doris Crawford, looked troubled. I had been working for the Voice of Prophecy only a short time, having accepted a call here soon after I became a Christian, just a few years out of high school. Both Doris and I were limited financially, so we shared a small apartment, hoping that someday we could afford a larger place.

"What's your burden?" I replied.

"My sister-in-law is leaving my abusive brother, and she has nowhere to go. She has three little girls and no money. Would it be OK with you if we took them in for a few weeks until she finds a job and is able to make it on her own?"

My heart was touched and I said, "Sure, Doris, let's do it."

That's how I met Bernice Davidson. Her girls, Beth, age 4, Carol, 8, and Ann, 10, were precious and easy to love, and the six of us became fast friends in spite of being crammed into a place that was barely large enough for two!

Piano-playing Calico Cat

It wasn't long before Doris felt she had to go to Pacific Union College in Northern California to fulfill a lifelong dream of taking pre-nursing. So then it was just my new family and me. Eventually we added another member to our family. Her name was Boleslaw Fries, a gorgeous calico cat (brown, black, orange, and white) that we named after a Voice of Prophecy Bible School student.

Boleslaw was not your ordinary cat. She was brilliant—the smartest animal I've ever known—and Carol took it upon herself to train her to roll over, jump through a hoop, shake hands (paws), and play the piano.

Bernice would say, "Play the piano, Bole," and she would leap up on the piano bench, plink one key, and then open her mouth for the

reward. Then we'd say, "That isn't good enough," and urge her to use both paws, at which point she would give us a "drop dead" look, growl, and comply. The only reason she didn't travel with me as my accompanist was that she couldn't transpose into the weird keys in which I sing! Enough about Boleslaw.

Fortunately, the Voice of Prophecy needed more Bible School instructors, and Bernice was taken on as an employee. It didn't take long for her to ingratiate herself to all our workers at the Voice of Prophecy. She was friendly, kind, a dedicated Christian, a fabulous worker, and very intelligent.

Bernice was an avid reader on religion and many other subjects, as was our founder and speaker, H.M.S. Richards, Sr. Many times at social occasions I would see them talking animatedly about the Civil War, science, astronomy, and other topics because they felt they could learn from each other.

I went away to college for four and a half years. I'd come home occasionally and share some of the things I'd learned—Bernice already knew all about it. And she didn't even have a high school diploma!

Some have said to me, "My, it was so good of you, at that tender age, to become involved with this family." However, I can assure you that I got as much or more than I gave! Bernice was a tremendous help and encouragement to me during those busy years when I was doing two jobs as a secretary and soloist.

Swapping Suitors' Letters

When I traveled, often for three to six weeks at a time, Bernice took care of my mail, which sometimes contained gifts for the Voice of Prophecy. She opened the letters, took out the checks and cash, and turned them in so that donors would receive receipts. Then she saw to it that I received the mail or that it was answered.

Bernice had quite a sense of humor. One time when I was away, she opened two letters from would-be suitors. Each said that the Lord had revealed to him that I was to marry him. She swapped the letters and sent them back to the two fellows, so each got the letter the other one had written.

When I returned home, she sheepishly told me what she had done and said, "I hope you aren't offended." I laughed heartily and said, "Not at all! I couldn't have handled it better myself!"

As time went on, the VOP leaders saw that Bernice had leadership ability, and from February 9, 1949 to 1972, she served as the supervisor of the Bible School. Following a severe stroke in September 1971, she had to take a leave of absence. But this plucky, determined lady was not about to throw in the towel permanently. She went back to work full-time from June 1975 to June 1985, after which she was a Bible School consultant until 1995.

Due to several crippling strokes, the quality of the last part of Bernice's life was not good, but what awaits her when Jesus returns and she is resurrected with all of God's saints will be fantastic!
