August 2/3 Titus: Leading for the Lord (CD #J61)

Paul recognized that being a leader for the Lord is full of challenges. The counsel in his letter to frequent traveling companion Titus can still strengthen churches today, as it did the early Christian church in Crete.

August 9/10 Philemon: Freedom in the Lord (CD #J61)

Young Onesimus ran away from his master—but Paul introduced him to his true Master. Then Paul came to his aid, helping him find true freedom in the Lord. His letter can help us find the same.

August 16/17 How to Be Great in the Kingdom (CD #J65)

The Pharisees tried very hard to get into the kingdom of God, but their righteousness missed the mark. How can we be assured that we'll have a place in the kingdom?

August 23/24 Hosea: God's Pleading Prophet (CD #J65)

It seemed he came out of nowhere to call Israel's leaders back to faith in the Lord. Hosea's whole life was a parable of the unfaithfulness of God's people. His words portrayed the stark contrast between what God wanted to do for His people and the results of their rebellion.

August 30/31 How to Get Rid of Your Enemies (CD #J69)

Rulers in Jesus' day usually got rid of their enemies with poison or the sword. But Jesus gave us a better way to deal with those who don't like us.

September 6/7 Hebrews: Exalt the Son! (CD #J69)

The book of Hebrews uplifts Jesus as no other book of the Bible does—pointing to the heavenly ministry He carries on for us today.

September 13/14 James: How to Be an Effective Christian (CD #J73)

In James's day, Christians faced persecution and many other difficulties. His book in the Bible is filled with practical counsel for living the Christian life in any and all circumstances.

September 20/21 1 Peter: Standing Through the Storm (CD #J73)

The Apostle Peter knew that a time of persecution was going to come upon the church, and he wrote this letter to

instruct the new Christians in how to be prepared to stand for Jesus, no matter what would come.

September 27/28 2 Peter: Standing on the Promises (CD #J77)

By the time this epistle was written, some had begun to doubt that Jesus would return. Peter calls the church back to faith in the promises of God, reminding us that God is both patient and just.

October 4/5 1-3 John: The Evidence Is In! (CD #J77)

In his letters to the Christians of his day, the apostle John revels in his memory of having been one to see and even touch Jesus—the great revelation of God's love. He appeals to us to continue to minister God's love even in difficult times.

October 11/12 Jude: A Call to Remember (CD #J81)

Heretical teachings crept into the church very early. Jude recalls Bible stories that make it plain that God will not allow error to go unchecked, and appeals to us to return to the pure faith.

October 18/19 Revelation: The Book of the End (CD #J81)

In our first program about the book of Revelation, we'll take a quick tour of the whole book, focusing on its great themes, and appreciating its wonderful promises of a brighter future for all who trust in Jesus.

October 25/26 The Prophecies of Revelation (CD #J85)

Revelation is a book filled with prophecies, and these great messages will be the theme of our second program on the last book of the Bible. What is its message for us, nearly 2000 years after it was written?
